The following is an on-going list of service organizations that the Troop will give a maximum of 3 hours credit for service hours performed towards the current rank. The 3 hour credit for each activity is a general assumption and it is the discretion of the Troop committee to override any of these service projects

1. Alter Server
2. Donut Sunday
3. Scouting for Food (1 hour for each Saturday the scout participates)
4. Beattyville – if the scout goes on the trip to Beattyville then more hours may be given. See Scoutmaster
5. Eagle Projects – depending on what the Eagle project is more hours will be given. See Scoutmaster
6. Tutoring
7. Help a Cub Pack with an activity
8. Working at a Vacation Bible school
